Course Summary

This is a comprehensive Institute of Physics-enabled course consisting of 6 one-day workshops in the autumn and spring terms, a 2-day residential in the Easter holidays and a one day conference (PhysMaths) to complete the course. Teachers will enhance their subject knowledge, explore teaching strategies and develop confidence in challenging misconceptions and building understanding in their





students. Guided lesson planning and mentor support, along with online learning resources, will provide participants with the tools needed to sustain progress once the course is completed.

A broad range of topics will be covered including electricity, sound and light, space, radioactivity, forces, heat transfer, electromagnetism and applications of physics. Starting with fundamental concepts and best practice in teaching at KS3, progressing to coverage of topics at KS4 and 5 with further practical emphasis. A tailored programme is delivered according to participants' needs. There will also be time to reflect, evaluate and feedback between sessions.

Cost
